Right or Wrong?

I have noticed a change in our society. There are some things that were once considered wrong, even illegal, that are now considered either okay or legal. Society has become more lawless in many areas, and the idea of obedience is not what it once was. Society is changing the idea of right and wrong.

What does the Bible say about this? God, after all, is the great lawgiver and law-maker. From Him we learn obedience and disobedience. Isaiah, the prophet, wrote, “Woe to those who call evil good and good evil; who put darkness for light, and light for darkness” (Isaiah 5:20). In the book of Romans Paul wrote about those who “did not like to retain God in their knowledge” (Romans 1:28).

Obedience is something the Bible emphasizes. Jesus saves those who obey Him (Hebrews 5:8, 9). Paul wrote that people should obey the gospel (Romans 10:16, 2 Thessalonians 1:8,9). Jesus stated, “If you love me, keep My commandments” (John 14:15). The Hebrew writer stated: “We have human fathers who corrected us, and we paid them respect. Shall we not much more readily be in subjection to the Father of spirits and live?” (Hebrews 12:9) What we learn in one area of life can often affect us in another. My concern is will happen to the souls of individuals who need to obey Christ when our society makes legal that which was once illegal? Will they obey the form of doctrine that was delivered by the apostles? (Romans 6:17)

We need to obey the Bible, no matter what man says. Peter and the other apostles said, “We ought to obey God rather than man” (Acts 5:29). When society says something is okay, we should see what God has to say. When society makes something legal, we need to check what the great lawgiver has in mind. When society promotes disobedience and rebellion, we need to look at what is written in God’s Word. God wants all men to be saved and to come to know the truth (1 Timothy 2:4). We can only do that if we know what it means to obey the laws which God has given.

Let us learn from the Scriptures and obey from the heart. (Romans 6:17)
