Possibility #1

The seven kings represent the seven pagan _____ that have opposed God's kingdom. Egypt (1), Assyria (2), Babylon (3), Medo-Persia (4), Greece (5) - the "five who have fallen", Rome (6) - the "one is". The 7th is any future anti-God nation.

Possibility #2

The seven heads which represent seven kings are actually seven _____ Roman emperors. This is based upon Daniel 7. Daniel says the 10 horns are 10 kings. John also refers to 10 horns being 10 kings, but that is in addition to the 7 heads also being kings. This approach makes the letter written during the rule of Vespasian which supports the earlier writing date and the book describing the fall of Jerusalem.

At issue is the fact that there is _____ during the reign of Vespasian that would have caused John to be exiled or explain the _____ described in the letter to Pergamum (Antipas). Plus, Victorinus (303 AD) states that John was exiled by Domitian.

Possibility #3
