What should be the deciding factor in determining whether the Good News of the Gospel should be silenced? I recall a scripture when religious leaders of the day were becoming more than concerned about the activities of the Apostles in the book of Acts.

"Then the high priest and all his associates, who were members of the party of the Sadducess, were filled with jealousy. They arrested the apostles and put them in the public jail. But during the night an angel of the Lord opened the doors of the jail and brought them out. 'Go, stand in the temple courts,' he said, 'and tell the people the full message of this new life.' " Acts 5:17-20 (NIV)

The high priest and their associates were burning in envy because the Apostles were presenting a new message of hope to the people. It was not a half-hearted proclamation instead it described a new life that no one had ever heard of before. The Gospel could be observed in the lives of God's messengers, even incarceration could not stop the persistent doctrine of truth.

Unfortunately the "Good News" remains bad news to those who do not recognize the authority of the scriptures.

"Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; and they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables." 2 Timothy 4:2-4 (KJV)

"Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that your brothers throughout the world are undergoing the same kind of sufferings." 1 Peter 5:8-9
